A visit to Google will turn up quite a few sources when you're looking for someone to build a website. If you need a website in a month and they are 3 months out, you may be better served by another designer. It's fair to note that once you do hire someone, their ability to complete your project depends heavily on your response time in supplying needed information.

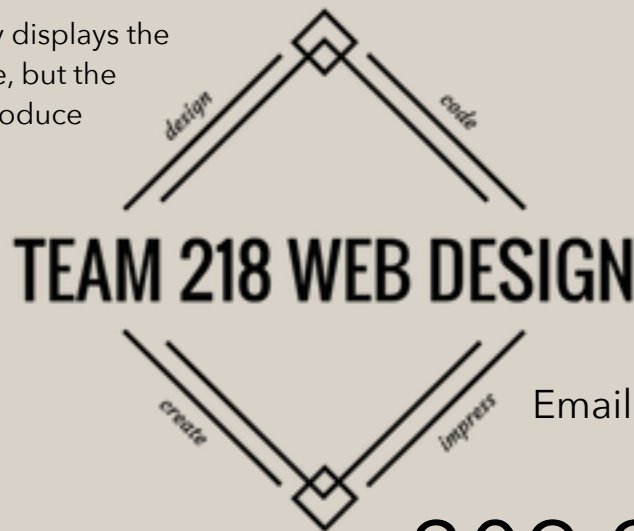
ETHICS
